Thank you for your request for information about Barkston and Syston, which we received on 17 December 2025. Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR).

You requested:

1. Wastewater catchment serving Barkston and Syston
2. Current and historic assessments relating to foul sewer capacity, headroom and capacity constraints
3. Storm overflow outfalls events for the last 10 years
4. Strategic statements on impacts on capacity in the Grantham / River Witham area
5. Correspondence relating to wastewater capacity in connection with major housing growth in the Grantham area
6. Details of any complete, ongoing or planned infrastructure upgrades since 2015 in the Barkston & Syston catchment.
7. Does Anglian Water monitor storm overflows in the catchment
8. Where any compliance issues, improvement notices or investigations recorded in the last 5 years

Item 1 is held by Anglian Water and has been provided below.

Barkston and Syston are served by the Marston (Lincs) Water Recycling Centre (WRC).

There are pumping stations in Syston (at the junction of The Drift and Main Street), and in Barkston (to the left of West Street).

Catchment boundary information is available on our website [DWMP hierarchy](#)

Item 2 is held by Anglian Water and has been provided below.

The WRC and upstream pumping stations have available capacity to accommodate additional flow, subject to site specific capacity checks.

There are no capacity assessment reports within the Syston and Barkston catchments from the past 8 years.

Capacity assessment responses to planning applications regarding new development from before this time or upstream of Syston (i.e relating to Great Gonerby, Manthorpe, Grantham, Barrowby etc), may be requestable from the South Kesteven Local Planning Authority.

Capacity assessments are required to be done on a site-by-site basis, as the impact of new development on our network will depend on the exact nature of the proposed development, the proposed connection point into our network, and factors such as the sites use and scale.
