Thank you for your request for information about Raunds STW, which we received on 25 January 2026. Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR).

You requested:

1. What stage are Anglian Water at in the planning for extending the sewage pipe from Raunds STW to Thrapston?
2. Has a preferred route been confirmed?
3. How will Anglian Water be using the Waters Act 1991 to complete this project?
4. What is a rough figure for the cost of a 6km sewage pipeline?
5. What is a rough construction timeline to install and connect a 6km sewage pipeline?
6. What is the scheduled completion date of this project?

EIR Response: Provision of Requested Information
