Thank you for your request for information about Gretton Brook Road, Corby, which we received on 5 February 2026. Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR).

You requested:

1. How many times has Anglian Water received calls about pollution, contamination and leaks at Gretton Brook Road, Corby in the last 10 years

EIR Response: Provision of Requested Information

Item 1 is held by Anglian Water and has been provided below.

Anglian Water has received 12 calls about pollutions. 3 were due to the misuse of the surface water drains in the area and were forwarded to the Highways Agency to investigate. The other 9 were due to burst water mains.

- 01/01/2026 – Potable water main burst
- 19/04/2024 – oil fly tipping – not AW pollution
- 02/02/2023 – potable water main burst
- 24/10/2023 – potable water main burst
- 04/01/2023 - potable water main burst
- 09/02/2022 - potable water main burst
- 07/02/2022 - potable water main burst
- 19/10/2021 – Not AW pollution. Highways to investigate
- 06/10/2020 – potable water main burst
- 22/05/2020 – potable water main burst
- 31/05/2019 - potable water main burst
- 01/11/2017 – Not AW pollution. Misuse of surface water drain

There has been 12 reports of leaks from the potable water mains.

There has been no reports of foul sewer overflows or pollutions in Gretton Brook Road, Corby.
